

## Spring 2018 Global Archives Sojourn April 22-28

You are invited to join us at the 10th Global Archives Spring Sojourn. We are in the process of **creating the imaginal and enticing structure of the website** into which we can pour the carefully contexted material of our history and mission to the world.

The plan is to use the **three strategies** developed early on in our work - **Contextual Re-education, Spirit Re-motivation and Structural Re-formulation**, to guide the presentation of program arenas on the site.

**Fleshing out of the origins of the EI/OE** with **video interviews describing the why and the how of our work** will provide a vital context for the website. Otherwise the three strategies are orphans without the integrity of an extraordinary "birth certificate". Under each of these imaginal, well-contexted strategies, we are choosing at least **two original program arenas** to illustrate each strategy. More can be added in future sojourns.

### THE THREE STRATEGIES

**Contextual Re-education:** Two collections, **Imaginal Education** and, surprising to all of us, the **Social Process**, sparked our interest. We were reminded of the difference the social process research made in our ability to respond to the needs of the world. We need to go through the imbalance-determining process again to get our minds around the **state of the civilizing process for today**.

**Spirit Re-motivation:** **The Other World** and a translated **New Mode of the Religious** (Jean's renaming), using various **profound journey constructs**, illustrate our historical and current spirit curriculum.

**Structural Re-formulation:** **Community Redevelopment, Fifth City & Participatory Methods** and the **Band of 24 Human Development Projects & Town Meeting** provide bold examples of transformation that many communities are looking for.

Another task, undergirding all three strategies, will be creating an **index of topics covered in JWM's talks**. We will also be creating **short descriptions of the stories videotaped during the Fall Sojourn**. Old hands will be needed to look and listen to these resources to help clarify their meaning to newer participants, and help us move beyond our familiar jargon.
